In English, our topic will focus on writing information texts. We will:

Explore different types of information texts including: non-chronological reports, biography, instructions, newspaper reports and posters,

Use —tion and —ness suffixes,

Use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech,

Express time, place and cause using conjunctions, adverbs or prepositions,

Group related material in our writing using paragraphs,

Use headings and sub-headings to aid presentation,

Use the present perfect form of verbs instead of the simple past,

Create expanded noun phrases through the addition of modifying adjectives, nouns and preposition phrases,

Create fronted adverbials with commas placed after them,

As our final piece we will write an information text about Howard Carter

Humanities
