- Finding pairs of values in 1 and 2 step problems as well as problems with two unknowns.

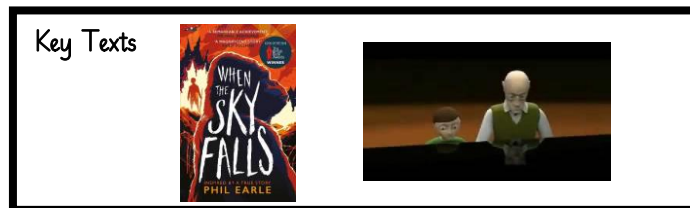
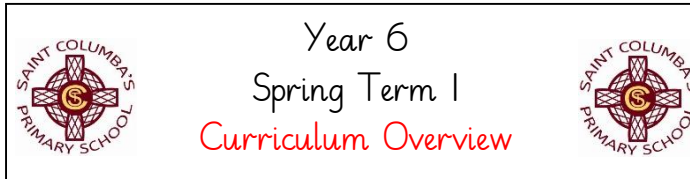
Fractions, Decimals and Percentages

- describe the ways in which nutrients and water are transported within animals, including humans

- explain who the suffragettes were, name key individuals and explain their impact
- explain how and why women's rights changed after WW2
- evaluate gender equality within modern day society
