Our whole school attendance from Reception to Year 6 for this week has been 93.4%. This means that we are in the amber zone and we are not meeting our targets set by the Department for Education.


However, we are delighted to announce that Year 2 are the winners of our attendance trophy with an overall attendance of 99.6%. Congratulations!

Afterschool Club - Pricing

From September, the Local Governing Body have decided that there will be a change to the pricing structure for Afterschool Club. This is to cover the rising costs of staffing costs, utilities and food. The decision has not been taken lightly; governors have thoroughly researched other provision in the area and we believe the following prices remain competitive.

For children using the club up to 4.30pm the cost will remain at £6.00

For children using the club beyond 4.30pm the cost will increase to £8.00
