English

In English, our topic will focus on informal letter writing. Using The secret of Black Rock we will:

Identify and use features of an informal letter

Explore and use features of mystery stories

Express time, place and cause using conjunctions, adverbs or prepositions

Use paragraphs as a way to group related material

Use the present perfect form of verbs

Use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech)

Explore fronted adverbials

Use of inverted commas to indicate direct speech

Fractions

- Count up and down in tenths
- Recognise, find and write fractions of a discrete set of objects: unit fractions and non-unit fractions with small denominators.

Maths

- Recognise and use fractions as numbers
- Recognise and show, using diagrams, equivalent fractions
- Add and subtract fractions of the same denominator
- Compare and order unit fractions

Science

Our Science topic this half term is 'Plants'. In this unit we will:

- Identify and describe the functions of different parts of powering plants.
- Explore the requirements of plants for life and growth.
- Investigate the way in which water is transported within plants
- Explore the life cycle of flowering plants.
