

We are delighted to have retained our forest school areas on the school premises. Miss O'Connor, our forest school lead, has plans to develop forest school sessions across the school throughout this academic year.

In order to develop this across the school, we need some work done in our forest area to cut away nettles, brambles and to help to prepare the areas for children to use; the new access from our temporary building is extremely overgrown. 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SeeSaw and X (Twitter)



We are keen to keep parents up to date with news, events and achievements within school. We know that many parents struggle to switch between children's accounts on SeeSaw — we are looking into this and hope to upgrade our system to include family logins as soon as possible.

Unfortunately, our recent Instagram account has not be sustainable. As we are a group rather than an individual, we need to have a business account. Business accounts can not be private on Instagram, therefore we feel this is not a suitable platform as we could not monitor who is accessing our content.

We do feel as though we need a social media platform where parents can view whole school news, rather than individual class news on SeeSaw. In order to do this, we are going to reuse and reopen our old Twitter account (now known as X). We have chosen this option as staff can approve followers, therefore we are able to control who views our images. You can follow us by searching for the handle: @stcolumbasrc

Staff will only approve family members that we can connect to a current pupil within school. If we are unsure of your identity, we may send a message to clarify this.

Pupil permissions for social media usage and image sharing will be sent out next week, via Microsoft Forms — no staff will post photos of children on any platform other than SeeSaw until then.
